I suppose it was more common to us than it is now for children to think about creating a side income. I can still remember my brother and I would try just about anything as long as we made money at it. Depending on your age, I am sure that you can remember back to when you as a young person selling lemon-aid on a street corner, delivering newspapers, going door to door and collecting old newspapers, selling Christmas cards, shoveling snow, and mowing lawns.

Not only did we try our hand at each of these, but I can also remember going door to door and collecting pop bottles to sell back to the grocery store, we would earn a nickel for each bottle we turned in. We even collected clothes hangers from the houses we

went to. At that time the local cleaners would give us three cents for each one we turned into them. We never seemed to run out of ideas for ways of making money.

I can remember going through the neighborhood and setting up a soda pop route. We would promise to deliver a six-pack of Shasta soda once a week for a small handling fee attached to it.

As children, we saw opportunities around every corner. Was that true for you? I know that it was for me. Like the time that I discovered a citrus-based weight loss program that was typed out on a small piece of paper on my parent's dresser. It read, "Lose Ten Pounds In Ten Days".

It didn't take me but two days before I had placed a classified ad asking for \$1 to learn the secret recipe to losing weight. And guess what, people would send me money!

What happened to us? Where did all of that creativity come from and where is it now?

The first time I met Joe Sabah, it was at a seminar that he was teaching. He told of an invention he had created as a young child. He remembers the times that he sat in class and watched as kids went to the teacher's desk to sharpen their pencils. They would insert the pencil in one end and as they did, they would grab the handle with the other and start grinding away. Joe thought to himself, wouldn't it be wonderful if someone could attach some kind of motor apparatus to that sharpener that would make it so that the pencils could be sharpened automatically. He went on to draw up plans in exact detail that would make the first electric pencil in the history of mankind possible. Wow, he thought to himself, what an idea!

Do you know what happened next? Joe took the paper that he had worked so hard on, tore it up and threw it in the trash can, and went to recess.

Ideas, we all have them, but what do we do with them? Well, the fact is that the majority of our ideas just sit there. For all intents and purposes, we do what Joe did that day in class, we wade them up and throw them away.

Ideas are a dime a dozen... the person who puts them into practice is PRICELESS!

A great example of this was my wife's uncle, Denny Proctor. Denny worked for a construction company.

His job was to go from construction site to construction site and treat freshly cured concrete foundations with a special waterproofing sealant. He would stand day after day spraying concrete solution with a special high-powered wand. One day he had an idea that would change his life forever!

What if someone created a high-pressure wand that everyday people could attach to their garden hose and use to clean their car with? In fact, they could use it to clean the exterior of their house, lawnmower, or anything else they needed to be washed.

Along with his brother, they created a special power washer and they called it, Jet-X Sprayer! You might remember seeing one of the many commercials that were run back in the 1970's selling Jet-X. To say the least millions of dollars of products were sold as a result of acting on one idea.



The Law of Recognition #2 The Windows of Heaven ARE Open

After three and a half years of drought in the land, the prophet declared that there was rain coming to the land! He spoke out what no one else could see, "Up on your feet! Eat and drink - celebrate! Rain is on the way; I hear it coming.

On your feet now! Look toward the sea." The servant went, looked, and reported back, "I don't see a thing." "Keep looking," said the prophet, "seven times if necessary." And sure enough, the seventh time he said, "Oh yes, a cloud! I see a very small cloud, no bigger than someone's hand, rising out of the sea."

Things happened fast after that, the sky grew black with wind-driven clouds, and then a huge cloudburst of rain.

The drought spoken of in this story was one of rain. But in terms of the subject of this book it is could be another type of drought, a drought of creative ideas.

As we grow out of our childhood it seems that over time we stop acting as quickly as we once did when it comes to the creative thoughts and ideas we once had. I'm not saying that we stop having ideas altogether, we just stop acting on them as frequently as we once did. The bad news is that once that takes place the creative juices that were once so alive in us slow down. We are less likely to think on our feet, we become more and more dependent on the ingrained systems and pathways of certain mindsets that we have become accustomed to.

In other words, over time we settle into those things we know for sure, those stationary things that we have become familiar with that support us and give us stability where it concerns who we are as a person. When we were young in many ways our unique identity was still in the making.

As we grow older we become more aware and concerned about the thoughts of others. The words of others telling us who we are hadn't taken root yet, words that tell us that you were stupid or smart were less likely to have settled in.

Here are five rules that will help you along the way

Insight Key #1 Believe that you are the same person that had all of those wonderful creative ideas when you were young.

Someone once said, "Seeing is believing" well take the opposite approach and say that believing is seeing. The prophet saw something that no one else could see that day, he saw that the rain was coming and that it was a time to celebrate. He moved past the drought-filled vision of everyone around him and declared the truth that he had become aware of, a vision of rain!

Realize and embrace that you have the same ability to generate ideas and create as you did as a child. You may have lost the spontaneity that you feel you once had but if you will embrace and celebrate the fact that you are the same person will help you along the way of becoming more creative.

"Up on your feet! Eat and drink - celebrate! The rain is on the way; I hear it coming."

Insight #2 Let go of preconceived notions that cause you to doubt and pre-judge the ideas that come to you.

The one thing that children usually have no shortage of that is a naïve innocence that keeps them open to creative ideas. They haven't learned the phrase, "No, it can't

be done" yet and because of that children are much more accepting of each other's imaginary play.

This is opposite to the way most people think in our day. Why can't we simply look at an idea without immediately throwing it to the ground? Think of yourself having your own private brainstorming session where no idea is scorned or criticized. Then, write them down! Don't worry, they are not cast in stone but they will open the doors of your mind to the one grand thought and idea that will bring you the answer.

Insight #3 Know and believe that you have the capacity to create something out of nothing.

You have to know and believe this beyond a shadow of a doubt! You have to realize that there is nothing impossible for those who believe.

I don't remember exactly when that "belief" entered my mind but one thing for sure I knew I had it. As a child, I specifically remember thinking to myself that if I applied myself I could create a way to achieve just about anything I wanted to. Now I have to admit to you, that many of those well-thought-out plans and ideas were not for my greater good.

Like the time I figured out a way to ditch classes in 6th grade for 30 days in a row without anyone finding out or how to get my brother and I into movie theaters for free.

Getting into the theater was as simple as telling the person taking tickets that my mom had sent me to find my brother who was in the movie and that I was supposed to get him home right away! The doorman would of course be suspicious and warn me that I had better come right back or he would come looking for me. Little did he know but my brother was standing outside of the exit door waiting for me to let him in. I would later leave the theater making sure that I was seen and was heard saying, "I can't find him anywhere, he must not be in there". You can probably guess what I did

then, I would head straight to the same exit doors where my brother was waiting and he would let me in for a day of enjoyment at the movies.

Incredible belief, this is what we all had as children. Somehow we just knew that we were capable of doing just about anything. You are still that special person that once believed that nothing was impossible.

Insight #4 Have Confidence, Inspired Idea's Will Come

If you understand and live out of an abundance mindset then you know that the answers are all around you. Creating ideas that create cash out of nothing can be difficult if you are no longer passionate about that thing that was once important to you. If you have accepted mediocrity in your life it is easy to become passive. Where there is passivity, inspiration refuses to flow. We can look back at many times in our lives and see where answers almost seemly appeared out of nowhere. If you will stop and think about it, the one central point was passion. Now answers can come in many forms, sometimes they are a knock at the door and someone hands you your answer. Other times it is an inspirational thought that you take action on.

While in college we made friends with an older couple who ran an Earthworm farm. In their back acreage behind the house, Mr. Gordon had built and placed long wooden troughs in rows where they raised earthworms that were later to be sold to local fish and tackle stores. Mr. Gordon told us that he would pay us six cents apiece to collect night crawlers in nearby parks. Well, we were certainly motivated enough and before long the ideas came pouring out that would enable us to accomplish the task at hand. We found an electric rod that could be put into the ground that would cause at least three or four crawlers at a time to come shooting out looking for relief. Oh, but we had one other problem... The parks didn't have electricity, now, how were we to get electricity out in the middle of all that grass? We soon found ourselves renting a gas-

powered generator to accomplish the task. We would later count out crawlers one by one by the thousands into buckets that we would deliver to Gordon's worm farm.

If you lived anywhere near the state capital of California in 1979 and you wondered what all that noise was all about at 3:00 in the morning, you now know. I wouldn't be surprised if while doing an overnight stint in the capital, Governor Jerry Brown himself didn't stare out through his window wondering what that crazy couple was doing.

Insight #5 You Got To Have Ambition

What is ambition and where does it come from? Ambition comes from the deepseated desires that materialize the object or aim of the endeavors that exist in our minds.

Before you can create and accomplish things you first must have ambition. And the only way that you can experience and feel ambition is if you have a hunger and desire that motivates your life.

Where does your ambition come from, what is it that creates motivation? Every man, woman, boy, and girl can stir ambition up in their lives.



The Law of Recognition #3 Opportunities Happen When You Are In Motion

This is a major point that most people miss out on and because they do, they are not able to seize the opportunity when it comes to them. Preparation is when you have a sense of direction in your life and you begin to make movement toward that direction no matter how small it may be.

Believe it or not, most people do not think in these terms. Typically people sit to wait for the opportunity to come or they wait before they make a move.

You must act upon the inspiration that is coming into your life every day!

You see every one of us has personal interests in our lives that cause us to reach for information continually. If this does not describe you and you have no idea what that what I mean here, then quite frankly you are stuck in a rut! You know the kind, all you see is where you came from and the tight narrow passage you've been walking on for the last 10, 20 years. On each side, all you see is dirt and it keeps you from having a peripheral vision, in other words, you can't see the opportunities that are already there.

In any case, opportunities are all around you! They see us but we just don't see them all the time. Here is the important thing I want to get across to you right now. When inspiration comes to you, no matter how small of an idea or thought it may be – Especially if it is tied to the core desires of your life, TAKE ACTION IMMEDIATELY!

If you are reading, searching, seeking to expand who you are, I guarantee that inspiration is taking place. The question is, are you acting on it? Studies have shown that inspiration has to be acted upon within 12 hours otherwise it starts to become hazy and lost. Put inspiration off for 24 hours, and you will not remember it at all and if you do, you will have difficulty recalling the details.

How do you take action? It could be as simple as writing it down and then exploring thoughts and information that has to do with the idea. Taking action is important because it will prepare you for other related opportunities. Most people sit and wait until they have all the information they need before taking action. They speculate about how they are going to pull the idea off and when they see roadblocks they stop cold.

You have heard the adage; it is hard to turn a car that is not moving! Well, it's true; once you start you will be surprised by additional ideas that will come to you.

Frogology and the importance of taking action

Here is something to think about. There were three frogs on a log and one decided to jump off. How many were left? Now before you rush off to the next paragraph, answer that question. How many were left on that log?

If you're like most people you thought to yourself, "Two," but you'd be wrong. You see, there's a difference between deciding and doing. The ability to move from simply deciding and quickly taking action is the one secret that created the next success story I'm about to tell you.

The One Idea That Took Us Around The World

My wife and I felt inspired to move to Little Rock, Arkansas from Denver, Colorado to attend a 1-year Missions school. We had an assurance in our hearts that this was the direction we should take. Our family did not think it was a good idea, after all, we just had our first child who was just 4 months old. We had no promise of a job waiting for us, we had enough to get there and pay for the first month's tuition and someplace to stay. The funny thing is that we hadn't applied yet for the school. We felt that by the time we sent our application and waited for approval, classes would have already started and it would be too late. We packed everything we had into an open-top U-Haul trailer and started down the road in our green Pinto. We must have been quite a sight when we pulled into town. It was Sunday morning and we were excited to be there. We didn't know anyone in Little Rock so drove straight to church that morning, parked, and went in.

They had all the visitors stand up that morning and announce who they were. We proudly told the audience that we had just driven in from Denver and were there to attend Agape School of World Evangelism! After the service, the dean of the school signaled and called us into his office. He told us that we should have sent in our application before coming and that we probably have wasted our time driving making this trip. Somehow we were not discouraged by what we were told, somehow we knew that everything would work out and we would be accepted. As it turned out we were accepted into the school and got started, but that did not solve the issue of money.

Then I had an inspirational idea. The idea was to start the Little Rock Christian Service Directory! Even though I had absolutely no experience, I knew that other students did. I thought this could be a great opportunity for creating an income for other students. I shared it with my classmates as well as with one classmate I sat next to who had experience in the printing business.

You probably can guess what their response was. Not one of them could see what I was so excited about. I was not swayed but continued to act on the inner knowing of the idea that had come to me. I placed an ad in the newspaper and hired two people on a commission-only basis, I then had another inspirational idea to contact the two Christian Radio stations in Little Rock and trade out advertising with them.

This gave me massive exposure to get my message out about the soon-to-be-published Christian Services Directory. Then, I had another inspired thought! The free advertising that I had been given could be used to leverage myself further. We were able to give away free radio spots to Christian businesses who advertised with us. My radio spots would advertise the Christian Services Directory and then I would showcase our advertiser of the day! We sold advertising, made money to pay for our one-year stay in Little Rock Arkansas, and were instrumental in publishing the first Christian business directory this city had ever seen. This entire endeavor was started with no out-of-pocket money, only an idea!

Oh, and let me add this thought here. As you are moving forward on the ideas and inspirational thoughts you have, other good things come your way as well.

As a result of acting on one inspirational idea of making a move across the country, we got to build relationships with the Filipino community in Little Rock who volunteered to collate the directory for us for free. An anonymous donor showed up one day at the school and paid for my entire year's tuition!

One of the Filipino friends we met had a relative in Manila and hosted us during our stay in that city. Because of this relationship, we were able to minister God's grace to the sister's daughter who was traumatized by something that had taken place in her life and as a result could not communicate and walk around like a zombie. She was miraculously healed and set free. We spent the next three years seeing God minister

to thousands of people. We witnessed many signs and wonders as a result some if I were to tell you would be difficult to get your mind wrapped around it all.

Hearing and acting on the inspiration in your heart will take you anywhere you want to go in life. It is all there, always available to take you to the next step.

It is one thing to notice the moments of inspiration in our lives and an entirely different experience to act on those moments. The following statements are a few common blocks that keep us in a state of inner paralysis, preventing us from going for it in life:

- "I can't do that"
- "Nothing ever works out for me"
- "I can't handle rejection"
- "I am not OK if this doesn't turn out the way I want it to"
- "What will people think?"
- "What if I fail?"

Realize that it is always better to step forward into growth than to step backward into safety. How can you be sure that you are taking action in your life? It is so easy to simply gather information without allowing it to have a positive effect on our lives. Here is one thing I am doing to solve this issue and I think it will help you as well.



The Law of Recognition #4

Money is a Representation of Value

To create money, just create value for other people. You can then always find a way to turn that into money.

That's a deep point, so you might want to pause for a bit if you haven't considered that before. Or, if you've heard it a million times before, read on, because now I'll show you how to CREATE value out of thin air.

Okay, let's go on to the REALLY good stuff!

How to create value in one easy step

Here it comes! An EXTREMELY easy formula for creating value:

Join two unrelated fields.

Like Andria Baldovin, a case study from Tim Ferris' *Four Hour Work Week*. She knew a lot about yoga and rock climbing, and she noticed some yoga exercises she knew were great for rock-climbers.

None of the rock-climbers knew them, because they didn't do yoga, and no yoga folks realized the exercises would be great for rock-climbers because they didn't climb. Only Andria, because she knew both fields, realized how much value she could bring to rock-climbers by teaching them the simple exercises. So she created instructional DVDs and now earns a nice living through that.

Or Brian Clark from copy blogger decided to join the fields of blogging and copywriting because he noticed how useful copywriting advice could be to bloggers. He has built a massively successful blog, by teaching bloggers to create catchy headlines, and snappy interesting content, by applying copywriting principles.

In both of the above cases, the entrepreneurs managed to literally **create money out of thin air**. Just by joining two unrelated fields, they knew about.

Action Step: The first step is pretty obvious. Pick two unrelated fields.

Now, you don't need to be an absolute expert at both of them. You just need to know quite a bit about one and have basic competence in the other.

For example, Andria didn't need to be anywhere near a stellar rock-climber to realize the yoga exercises would be great for climbers. It takes only a few sessions to realize which muscles always end up stiff after climbing. And she just needed to know a bit about yoga to know that those exercises existed.

If you're not sure which two fields of your expertise you could join, that's quite natural. First, grab a piece of paper. (In fact, even if you already have an idea, do this anyway.)

Then, on your piece of paper, write all the fields you're good at. Yes, all of them. There will probably be dozens.

Then, if you want, make another list of all the fields you have basic competence in. This way you have more options.

And now the next step...

What to look for - Why this works

This process works because there are always some things that are completely obvious and common in one field, but an absolute revolution in another field.

The Power of Incubation

The subconscious mind is a powerful force that works for you twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week, without your knowing it. We learn this in biology 101. Our subconscious sends constant signals to our heart, lungs, and body.

The subconscious has laser-beam focus where it concerns getting what you really want. It is the master genie in the bottle and currently at work right now in your life. It causes you to instantly see things that no one else around you can see. It causes you to know things intuitively about people around you in the flash of a moment.

But you also need to realize that the subconscious mind can be your best friend or your worst enemy, it all depends on you. If you have learned how to stroke the genie bottle of your mind in the correct manner it will work constantly to bring you the knowledge you need for your next step or opportunity. Stroke it with apathy and old habits and will keep you stuck in old patterns for your entire life.

Incubation is recognizing the power of this unseen force and putting it at your command. How is this done? You program your subconscious by focusing your conscious mind on what it is you really want, a question you need to have answered, a problem that you need solving, or a lost item that you need to find, and then taking your conscious mind off of that subject and relaxing.

You probably have experienced this yourself at times when you lost your car keys or some other important item. You looked and you looked, and finally, when all else failed and you turned your attention elsewhere, the answer popped into your mind seemingly out of nowhere.

This is your subconscious mind at work and it is applied the moment your mind rests on it in some concentrated form. Then the moment you relax your thoughts, the answers come. You may also have experienced this when you needed to wake up at a certain time in the morning. Tell your subconscious to awaken you at such and such time and it will usually do the job better than the alarm clock on your smartphone.

I hope you are seeing the power of what this can mean to you. The moment you decide what it is you really want in life is the moment genius is released to bring it to pass.

Maybe the Secret of Attraction isn't a big secret after all; maybe we have just misunderstood it.

Peepholes for People

As newlyweds, we were desperate for extra money. We searched and searched for something we could do on the side to bring in a little bit more income into the household.

After a few days, an idea came. I went to the store and purchased a battery-operated drill with a holster I could attach to my belt. You might call me crazy because I spent what little money we had on that drill. I also called around to some wholesale construction hardware stores. Hello, do you sell Peepholes for doors?

Now if you're not in the U.S. you might not be familiar with a peephole. It is a small apparatus that many homes have in their front doors. It allows the homeowner to view or peep through to see who may be standing on their front step. Most Motels have one of these on each guest door.

After finding the best possible price I showed up at the store and bought everything they had in stock.

You might be wondering, "Scott, what in the world are you up to?" That night Debra and I started our new sideline business as we walked up and down the street, Debra on one side and I on the other. We would knock on doors that didn't have a peephole.

Action Step: Decide what it is you really want in life. If you are dealing with financial issues, begin to see the end of where you want to be. Spend enough focus here at the beginning of your incubation period and before long ideas will pour out like rainfall from heaven. Ignore the ideas that come to you, discount them in the least bit, and you will come to think you are in the middle of the worst drought of your life.

A few last words...

The most important thing I can tell you is to **start acting on your ideas right now!** Don't put it off, don't procrastinate... Tomorrow will never come!

The second most important thing is to **believe in yourself!** If you don't believe in yourself, how can you believe in the ideas that you have?

The third thing is to **get by yourself and practice getting quiet.** In a hectic world, this isn't always easy or convenient, but as you get in touch with what it is that you really want in life, ideas will begin flooding in.

Realize that "Nothing is impossible to them that believe." Believing does not mean "fake it till you make it." It is not forced believism. It is working on yourself, your beliefs about you, and your world until the reality of your capacity and capability sets in. I call it, taking ownership!
